TIME: 5.30pm red carpet arrival. Ceremony will commence promptly at 6.00pm.

Ceremony is from 6.00pm – 7.30pm, Supervised Dinner & Disco 7.30pm – 10.00pm
(children can be collected from 9.00pm).

GUESTS: We have a strict limit of numbers for the venue due to COVID restrictions. Each child is allowed to have 2 guests attend the ceremony. Please respect this venue policy.

COST: \$25.00 per child: includes entertainment, dinner, desert, drinks and snacks during the disco. Please contact the school if you or your child have any special dietary requirements e.g. vegetarian, vegan, gluten free etc. Payment can be made at student services or via internet banking (details on invoice). Combined invoices will be sent for this event and an upcoming excursion. The school has subsidised both these events.

Students will need to meet their teacher on the grassed area at 5.45pm on the night of graduation to prepare for the formalities.
